#### **PROGRAM REPORTS**

#### Lunch For-a-Buck

Six ELCA congregations, Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Christ the King Lutheran Church, Epiphany Lutheran Church (Eagle Lake), Grace Lutheran Church, Messiah Lutheran Church (North Mankato), and Our Savior's Lutheran Church (Cleveland) – along with their 50 volunteers – prepared, provided, and served lunch to Minnesota State University-Mankato students and faculty on 30 Tuesdays during Spring and Fall Terms in 2024.

A total of 1,430 individuals were served lunch while the volunteers also collected \$1,191.29 in donations that were used to purchase lettuce salad, croutons, dressing, beverages, cups, paper plates, silverware, and additional supplies for future lunches.

Hunger and food insecurity are real on the campus of Minnesota State University-Mankato. We are grateful for our partnerships with area congregations who support the students and the ministry at Crossroads. We would not be able to feed the Lord's sheep without them.

#### Food Support – Campus Cupboard

Campus Cupboard food pantry provides food to any student with a current ID from MSU-Mankato, South Central College, or Bethany College. It is open Tuesdays, 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM and Thursdays, 12:00 PM to 5:30 PM.

- In an average month, the Cupboard serves 404 households and distributes 15,832 pounds of food.
- In the summer of 2023, we moved Campus Cupboard to the main level of the Crossroads building. It has been a great move! Campus Cupboard is now housed in half of Crossroads' gathering area, which is an excellent use of space and allows us to serve more students at the same time and offer a wider variety of products.
- In 2024 we averaged 1064 adults per month and gave away a total of 189,987 pounds of food. This is an increase from last year! We served students, their children and in some cases their parents.
- Much of the food was purchased from the Second Harvest Heartland food bank. We also
  participated in food rescue with Cub Foods West, who provided about 33% of the food we
  distributed without charge.
- We cannot express how great our appreciation is for the on-going support of civic groups. In 2024, we were blessed to receive two nights of food donations from the Kiwanis Holiday Lights, totaling 616 pounds. Mavs in Action at MSU regularly donate various in-kind donations. Minnesota Women of Today donated 145 pounds of food as well as a financial

- contribution. We also extend our gratitude to PEO for their cash donation in addition to 55 pounds of groceries. Our heartfelt thanks to the SE MN synod, for your faithful support as well.
- We are pleased to announce that Campus Cupboard was selected by the Mayo Clinic Health System as a recipient of a Hometown Health Care Grant. These grants are awarded to support community efforts that address identified community health needs. The grant amount of \$7,500 provides enough funding for 2 months of purchases under our Current Budget. We are very thankful for the support of the Mayo Clinic Health System.
- We depend on grants and donations to do the work that we do. We appreciate your support!

#### Facility Rental:

The facility was rented on six occasions during 2024, with a \$75 janitorial fee for use of the space. The six events included an event for the Nepalese Student Organization, an event for a campus fraternity, a college graduation party, a band practice for a student band, and two pancake breakfast fundraisers.

#### Outreach

Pastor Jenna has been out and about at various events throughout campus, the community, and the synod. She has done several tabling events at events such as the WELCA Spring Conference meetings, Synod Assembly, Fall Theological Conference, Mankato's Pride event, and a Community Expo resource fair at the Blue Earth County Library.


Pastor Jenna also represented Crossroads at the MNSU Homecoming Parade with a float, and she and her husband Mike dressed up in costume for Halloween and handed out candy at the Haunted Takeover at the Student Union on the 30<sup>th</sup> of October. Next year, she plans to organize a Trunk or Treat event for college students in collaboration with Mavs in Action! And, of course, she has been to several congregations in the Synod to preach about the ministry we do here at Crossroads. She is always on the lookout for new ways to partner with community and



broader church organizations to get the students the resources they need to thrive.



#### New Fundraiser



This year, Crossroads has launched a new year-long fundraising campaign called **A Day** in the Life of Crossroads. The goal of this fundraiser is simple: to fill each day of an entire calendar year with a financial sponsor.

Here's how it works:

Each date of the year is assigned a donation amount that corresponds to its place in the calendar. For example:

- January 1st (the 1st day of the year) = \$1
- March 17th (the 76th day of the year) = \$76
- December 31st (the 365th day of the year) = \$365
